## 2. Minerals Systems Workshops

A generic mineral systems workshop is being planned to explore the Mineral Systems concept and illustrate its application to exploration. Specific examples will be discussed and the workflow appropriate for a Mineral Systems analysis will be presented and examined.

The Mineral Systems workshop will be run three times, at the following dates and locations:
